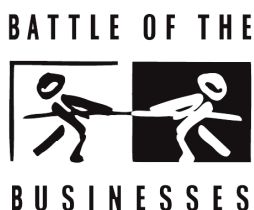
SPECIAL OLYMPICS OF GREATER DAYTON FACTS

- Special Olympics of Greater Dayton has been in existence since 1974. It began as a one day event offering two sports: swimming and track & field.
- Special Olympics of Greater Dayton offers year-round training to over 700 athletes with intellectual disabilities in the Montgomery County area and offers competitive events to an additional 300 athletes in surrounding counties. Teams are formed through public and private schools, residential facilities, parent groups, work places, and parks & recreation departments. Individuals may also register as independents.
